**Today's gua is Love & Marriage.**



Love & Marriage gua envelops our senses. The I Ching trigram associated with Love & Marriage is K'un translated as Receptive Earth. It brings visions of soft, warm, and nourishing earth. Have you ever been in a freshly plowed field, garden, or flowerbed and put your hands down into the earth? Close your eyes and imagine sliding your hands in and feeling the soft warmth as you let the earth trickle through your fingers. Feel as you give your energy and life force, you receive back from the earth in equal measure. It is a circle of giving and receiving unconditionally.

The Love & Marriage gua invites us to experience our senses. Smell, sight, touch, and taste are all satisfied by nourishing the intimate space of our heart and expressing it in our life.

In my experience as a Feng Shui Practitioner, the bedroom, regardless of what gua it falls into for the Bagua of the house, is reflective of the intimate relationship of its occupants. Two halves make a whole but two wholes make a pair. When two people come together in unconditional support, respect, and love of each other, the pair is empowered and uplifted.

The most intimate relationship we have our whole life is the one with ourselves. Remember the Law of Attraction? Like energy attracts like energy. How we love, respect, and treat ourselves is the vibration we are sending out. It draws back to us the matching energy. If we do not love or treat ourselves with respect, how will we draw a partner or relationships that do? Yesterday, we looked to the gua opposite Fame & Reputation. Today, we look to Knowledge & Self-Cultivation. Go back and look at how you answered your questions. As you think about the relationship with yourself and how you cultivate that

relationship, does it give you any additional information for relationships?

A few years ago, I heard Rhonda Britton speak. She is a life coach and someone asked her about relationships and affirmations. She took the affirmation, "I want to be in a loving relationship," and changed it to, "I am loving in all of my relationships." That appears to be a minor change. To me, the change is dramatic. Stating, "I am loving in all of my relationships," puts me in the creative stance that empowers me in all of my relationships including the one with myself. It is me taking responsibility for how I am in my relationships and creates the vibration I am sending out and what I am receiving in return.

What does love mean to you? What does it smell, feel, taste, and look like? Are you loving in all of your relationships?

Ask your questions:

*What is my intention?*

*How do I live my intention?*
